#### About the Position

The Public Works Department is seeking an enthusiastic and talented individual to fill this key role in its **Water Resources Division**. The successful candidate will work as part of the engineering team to provide moderately difficult and responsible engineering work in the areas of drainage, stormwater quality management, and water resources and supply.



#### Minimum Qualifications

**Pattern I—Experience:** Two years as an Engineering Assistant I in San Joaquin County Service

**Pattern II—Experience:** Four years performing field and office engineering work with at least two years experience comparable to an Engineering Assistant I in San Joaquin County. **Education:** Completion of 60 semester units from an accredited college or university with major coursework in engineering science, construction management, or a related field. **Substitution #1:** Additional varied field and office engineering experience may be substituted for the required education on a year-for-year basis. **Substitution #2:** Additional education may be substituted for the required experience on a year-for-year basis, to a maximum of two years.

**License:** Possession of a valid California driver's license.

#### Compensation, Benefits and Schedule
