San Joaquin County Public Health Services-California Children's Services (CCS) department is seeking a motivated and dedicated professional to join their staff as an Occupational Therapist-Senior in the Medical Therapy Program unit. This is an excellent career opportunity for an experienced licensed occupational therapist who will perform occupational therapy evaluations and treatment planning in a Medical Therapy Unit (MTU) for children ages birth to 21 years with qualifying medical conditions.

The Occupational Therapist-Senior is an integral part of the CCS/MTU team, who will have the opportunity to:

- Work in a culturally sensitive team-oriented environment
- Use an advanced level of clinical skill while performing a variety of occupational therapy services for an array of disabling conditions
- Work in a diverse setting while caring for the occupational therapy needs of children in San Joaquin County



-California Children's Services-

CCS is a statewide program that manages, directs, and pays for medical care, equipment, and rehabilitation when services are authorized by the program. Services can be authorized for children and young adults less than 21 years of age who have eligible medical conditions, and whose families are unable to pay for all or part of their care. CCS defines eligibility and selects the most qualified professionals to treat the child's CCS-eligible condition.

-Medical Therapy Program-

The Medical Therapy Program (MTP) is a specialized program within CCS services that includes Occupational Therapy and Physical Therapy for children ages birth to 21 years with eligible conditions including: cerebral palsy, spina bifida, and muscular dystrophy. Therapy services are provided at outpatient rehabilitation units located in public schools in Lodi, Stockton, Manteca, and Tracy.

The Occupational Therapist-Senior is the senior class in the Occupational Therapist series and performs skilled diagnostic and therapeutic occupational therapy techniques for a variety of disabling conditions.

Typical Duties Include

- Performs occupational therapy evaluations and interprets findings
- Plans and implements occupational therapeutic treatment for patients; establishes appropriate treatment goals; uses equipment properly
- Coordinates treatment programs with physicians, nurses, professional, and para-professional staff
- Attends staff meetings and patient conferences; conducts and/or attends in-service education programs for a variety of departmental personnel; may assist with departmental orientation of new staff
- Maintains accurate records and prepares written reports
- May act as lead therapist or provides instruction to other Occupational Therapists, Occupational Therapy Assistants and other professional or para-professional staff; may assist in coordinating occupational therapy internship programs; may consult with supervisory staff and provide input into employee and intern evaluations
- May assist with departmental projects

APPLICATION and SELECTION

Applications are being accepted to fill one existing full-time vacancy and to establish an eligible list to fill future vacancies. If a formal exam process is used, qualified applicants will be invited to an oral examination interview. The top-scoring candidates will be referred to the department for a hiring interview. To apply, submit a completed application and supplemental questionnaire to Human Resources. Resumes are not accepted in lieu of application.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

EITHER PATTERN I

<u>Experience</u>: One year of experience as an Occupational Therapist in San Joaquin County.

OR PATTERN II

<u>Experience</u>: Two years of progressively responsible experience as a licensed occupational therapist performing diagnostic and/or therapeutic occupational therapy techniques for a variety of disabling conditions.

AND FOR BOTH PATTERNS

<u>License</u>: Must possess and maintain a current license as an Occupational Therapist issued by the State of California Board of Occupational Therapy; and if required by the nature of the assignment, must also possess and maintain a valid California driver's license.
