

The Placer County Counsel's office, located in Auburn, is recruiting for a Deputy County Counsel position in the practice area of child protective services. Candidates must be an active member of the California State Bar and experience in child dependency is preferred. Applicants are encouraged to identify in their application materials experience and/or strength in this area.

The County Counsel's Office is a department of the County of Placer. It consists of 24 employees, including 16 attorneys. The Office of Placer County Counsel is headed by the County Counsel, an attorney who is a direct appointment of the Board of Supervisors. The office structure is similar to a traditional law office, providing in-house transactional and civil litigation services to its client population.

The vacant position will be filled at a Deputy County Counsel II/III/IV level. The position level and starting salary will be determined by candidate qualifications, salary history and career accomplishments.

The position in child dependency would include providing advisory and litigation services primarily in the areas of child protective services, including research and appeals. The application materials should include a cover letter and two writing samples.
