About the position

This position will provide technical engineering support within Capital Projects Administration for the annual BOS approved Capital Improvement Program (CIP) work plan. Additionally, this position will act as the lead technical staff for field and office engineering work in connection with assigned design and construction projects.

This position will report to the Capital Projects Administrator and will apply non-licensed engineering and drafting techniques for mechanical, electrical and civil (including structural and/or transportation) engineering drawings and other graphic material by utilizing computer based software products such as AutoCAD, Google Earth, Bluebeam, Map 3D, Civil 3D and/or Revit and will also provide lead technical expertise for CIP work plan objectives, primarily for existing facilities construction projects by way of task orders through the Job Order Contracting program and other County sanctioned procurement options.

Minimum Qualifications:

Experience: Two years of varied technical engineering experience at a level comparable to an Engineering Aide in San Joaquin County service.

<u>Substitution</u>: College coursework in engineering science may be substituted for the required experience on a year-for-year basis.

License: Possession of a valid California driver's license.
