PURPOSE OF JOB CLASS (NATURE OF WORK)

In a state agency this class is accountable for performing the most complex accounting tasks within a variety of accounting programs and systems. This class may also be accountable for lead or consultative responsibility.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Establishes and implements accounting sub-systems such as procedures for paying and collecting activities, procedures for issuance of grants, loans or subsidies, establishment of rates or schedules of fees, establishment of account charts for classification of transactions; maintains fiscal controls by authorizing non-routine

Make sure you meet the Minimum Qualifications on the Job Opening and Apply

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: GENERAL EXPERIENCE

Four (4) years' experience above the routine clerk level in office support or secretarial work.

SPECIAL EXPERIENCE

One (1) year of the General Experience must have been as a Secretary 2 or its equivalent.

SUBSTITUTIONS ALLOWED

College training in the secretarial sciences may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of 15 semester hours equalling one-half (1/2) year of experience to a maximum of two (2) years.

Note: The Manager and/or Director level designation is reserved for incumbents with full time responsibilities for a major program. Their work is broadly guided by department policies and goals, and they usually report to the highest level administrators within an organization. The Manager and/or Director will have supervisory responsibilities, but the emphasis of the position will be on management activities. These activities can include such things as formulating program goals and objectives, developing and implementing program policies and procedures, developing and maintaining the program budget, identifying and coordinating both internal and external resources, maintaining high level and sensitive contacts with the public, officials, etc. and regularly acting as the representative of the department on sensitive program related activities.

A determination as to whether or not you meet the minimum requirements (MMQ) of the position will be made based upon the information you submit when you apply for each Job Opening.

Appeal Process- Classified Competitive Positions Only

There is an appeal process for competitive positions only for individuals who **do not meet the minimum qualifications or special requirements** of the position.

You will be sent an email if you are eligible to appeal a job opening for which you have applied. Appeals must be made within 12 calendar days of notification and submitted to ExamAppeals@ct.gov. A decision will be made within 15 days of receipt of appeal.

Applicants cannot appeal the designation of a job opening: Open to the Public, Open Only to State Employees or Open Only to Agency employees.





Selection

- The hiring agency will review the eligible list.
- You will be notified via email to self-schedule an interview, if the hiring agency further considers your application.
- The hiring agency will notify you whether or not you are the selected candidate.
