KEY ELEMENTS

PROGRAM RESPONSIBILITY	ORGANIZATIONAL IMPACT	MANAGERIAL COMPLEXITY
This level represents upper level managers with responsibility for agency wide divisions/bureaus; management of major locations or managing a statewide function.	Focus is on strategic planning and policy development that involves innovative thinking and affects agency's mission. Responsibility involves establishing budget, work direction and priorities for large sections of the agency with influence on other internal and external organizations.	Requires the use of sophisticated, complex and varied management principles and practices involving integration & leadership of advanced managers and professionals in development of policy and strategic initiatives effecting the statewide information technology services. Administrative complexity includes development and administration of major budgets with either multiple large agency or statewide impact; development and implementation of information technology strategic plans for statewide services.
SUPERVISION	EXPERIENCE & TRAINING	
Incumbents at this level typically will supervise multiple staff or projects and programs including lower level managers, advanced technical staff, professional staff and supervisors or consultants.	Requirements at this level consist of ten (10) years of experience in computer or network administration, architecture, operations, production control, systems development and information technology analysis and planning, including one year in a managerial capacity at the level of IT Manager 2
