Responsible for providing leadership to all levels of managers assigned to the agency. Assists the Chief Information Officer with the overall administration of information technology services in the state. Significant influence on external and internal groups.</p>	<p>Requires the use of sophisticated, complex and varied management principles and practices involving integration & leadership of advanced managers and professionals in development of policy and strategic initiatives effecting the statewide information technology services. Administrative complexity includes development and administration of agency and division budgets, development and implementation of agency's information technology plans; strongly influences the decisions regarding information technology services in the state.</p>

<p>Incumbents at this level are responsible for supervising multiple managers in their respective divisions.</p>	<p>Requirements at this level consist of ten (10) years of experience in computer or network administration, architecture, operations, production control, systems development and information technology analysis and planning, including three (3) years in a managerial capacity at the level of IT Manager 2.</p>
